Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on the access roads leading to “Morrisons Car Park” for the purpose of a Fun Fair in association with Barnard Castle Meet.

Background

A Fun Fair is proposed to be held by Ryan Crow in the week preceeding and up to Barnard Castle Meet Weekend requiring temporary road closure of the access into the car park from Wed 24/05/17 to Monday 29/05/17.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary restriction of this area, in preference over other areas.
