TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Tuesday 27 June through to Friday 30 June 2017 for the purpose of preventing obstruction of the highway of Durham peninsula during University Congregation.

Background

Durham University Congregation is scheduled around on the peninsula area of Durham (and Palace Green) which will cause the area to be thronged with people within the confines of the highway.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary closures to vehicular traffic
