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**Purpose of the Report**

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Sunday 12 November for the purpose of preventing obstruction during the holding of Durham City Remembrance Day Parade on roads between Durham Cathedral and Claypath between 11am and noon.

**Background**

The annual Durham City Remembrance Day Parade is proposed to be undertaken between 11 am and noon on Sunday 12/11/17 within the confines of the highway.
