#### **Purpose of the Report**

- The purpose of the report is to seek approval to
  - a) Declare Cleversferye House on Lambton Road, Ferryhill surplus to Council requirements; and,
  - b) Dispose of the above building in a single transaction on the open market.

#### **Background**

- The site is edged red on the attached plan and extends to approximately 0.41 ha (1.01a).
- The intention is to dispose of this building, and associated land surrounding the building.
- The building on the site, which is two-storey on the northern block and single storey to the south, and was last used as office accommodation within CYPS. Staff were relocated to Morrison Busty in March and the building has been de-commissioned.

#### **Current Position**

- Services, including the Office Accommodation Team, have been consulted and have not identified a requirement to retain the site for existing or future service delivery use.
- The Portfolio Holder and Local Members have been consulted and have not made any observations or raised any concerns. Councillor Atkinson has request further information on the process for disposal which has been addressed.
- 7 Strategic Partners and Ferryhill Town Council have been consulted. Partners have not made any comments or raised any objections
- 8 Technical consultations have been undertaken and the Tree Officer has raised concerns on the retention of a significant groups of trees on the western and eastern boundaries of the site. These concerns will be addressed through the planning process
