Purpose of the Report

- 1 The purpose of the report is to seek approval to
 - a) Declare Consett Former Swimming Baths surplus to council requirements
 - b) Dispose of the site

Background

- The site is edged red on the attached plan and amounts to approximately 2.28 acres (0.92ha).
- The site was formerly used for Consett Swimming Baths. As part of the Building Schools for the Future (BSF) programme a new swimming pool was built in conjunction with the new build Consett Academy and Leisure Centre complex at Belle Vue.
- The site is cleared following the demolition of the former swimming baths building in 2016.
- The site is identified as being suitable for residential development within the councils Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment that was updated in 2015. (SHLAA/Site 1/CO/11)

Recommendations and reasons

- Following the relocation of the swimming baths the site is now surplus to service requirements.
- 7 It is recommended to declare the site surplus to Council requirements and dispose of the site.
