Purpose of the Report

1 To note the application of the Board of Trustees of the Science Museum Group ('SMG') to be an admission body in the Durham County Council Pension Fund ('the Fund').

Background

- 2 As part of the transfer of responsibility for running the Locomotion museum and an associated transfer of employment from the Council to SMG, SMG has applied to be admitted to the Fund as a new employer.
- 3 SMG has fulfilled all the requirements set out in the regulations governing the Local Government Pension Scheme to allow it to become an admission body employer. This means the Council is obliged to allow SMG to become an admission body employer in the Fund.
- 4 As part of the negotiations of the transfer of responsibility, the Council has agreed that SMG can be pooled with the Council for the purpose of setting employer contribution rates in the Fund. This arrangement is reflected in the admission agreement.

5 As SMG has fulfilled all the criteria set out in the regulations, the Council has to admit it to the Pension Fund – this means there are no alternative options to consider.
