**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER**

Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on 20/04/18 over a 3 day period for the purpose of accommodating the Bishop Auckland Food Festival on and adjacent to the highway.

Background

The annual Bishop Auckland Food Festival is proposed, requiring traffic to be managed between Friday 20 April to Sunday 22 April 2018, within the confines of the highway.

Details of any alternative options considered and rejected when making the decision

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for temporary closure and one-way restriction suspension and taxi rank closure/suspension.

Recommendations and reasons

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event
