**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION

Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Sunday 3 June 2018 for the purpose of permitting a vehicle rally to pass through Sedgefield, Coxhoe and Durham.

Background

The Historic Commercial Vehicle Society propose to undertake the Tyne Tees Run vehicle rally and require exemption from the environmental weight restricted areas of Sedgefield, Coxhoe and Durham.
