#### **Purpose of the Report**

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Saturday 23 June 2018 for the purpose of preventing obstruction when the streets are liable to be thronged owing to the holding of the RAF 100 year North East Salute event.

#### **Background**

An event is proposed to be undertaken within the confines of the highway between noon and 4.30 pm on Owengate with additional closures required between 3.00 and 4.30 on Saddler Street, North Bailey and Dun Cow Lane.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for short term temporary closure to vehicles.
