Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Saturday 9 June 2018 for the purpose of preventing obstruction when the streets are liable to be thronged owing to the holding of the Bowes Carnival Procession between 1.00 and 1.25 pm.

The annual Bowes Carnival Procession is proposed to be undertaken within the confines of the highway.
