

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM**

**ORDER**

**Section 21 of The Town Police Clauses Act 1847 For The Prevention Of**

**Obstruction of Streets set out in this Order**

**WHEREAS** between **8 June 2018 to 11 June 2018** the footpaths specified in the Schedule hereto will be thronged and liable to be obstructed because of the holding of the **Durham Regatta on 9/10 June 2018**.

The County Council of Durham, pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of The Town Police Clauses Act 1847, does **HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT** that, for the purposes of preventing obstruction, the said footpaths shall be closed during this time to all pedestrian traffic, with the exception of access for emergency personnel, upon the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform or any person so authorised by the Committee of the Durham Regatta who may demand admission to the said closed parts of the banks of the River Wear with appropriate charges per day in association with Section 7(3) of the Durham City Council Act 1985.

The penalty for infringement of the said regulation is a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

**Footpaths Nos, 47 & 48 Durham City**

1. Footpath No. 47 between the Baths Bridge and the junction with Footpath No. 48
2. Footpath No. 48 between Footpath No. 47 (east of Baths Bridge) and Durham Amateur Rowing club
