**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION

Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Saturday 3 November 2018 for the purpose of preventing obstruction when roads in Gainford are liable to be thronged owing to the holding of the Gainford Bonfire and Fireworks Display.

Background

The annual bonfire and fireworks display is proposed by Gainford Parish Council that will generate thronging on the highway.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for short term road closures during the event.

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event in a safe manner
