TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Saturday 29 September 2018 for the purpose of preventing obstruction when the streets are liable to be thronged during the holding of the Bishop Celebrating Together event.

Background

An event is proposed to be undertaken within the confines of the highway on Saturday 29/09/18 from 6am to 4pm prohibiting vehicular traffic on the northbound carriageway of Castle Chare and Market Place, Bishop Auckland.

Details of any alternative options considered and rejected when making the decision

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is to prohibit vehicular traffic on that section of highway.

Recommendations and reasons

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event.

The recommendation is approved and that following, consultations with the Chief of Police, arrangements be made to progress the sealing of an Order.
