**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION

Purpose of the Report

To consider a request for temporary traffic regulation by Order on Monday 5 November for the purpose of preventing obstruction and helping to facilitate the management of vehicles and pedestrians during the holding of the Aykley Heads Fireworks Display.

Background

Durham Police and Fire Service proposed to undertake a Fireworks Display whereby the adjacent roads and paths are liable to be thronged.

Other traffic management arrangements have been considered and the most appropriate method is for short term temporary closure on as as-required basis

Recommendations and reasons

It is recommended that the Council exercises its powers under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to effect a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to facilitate the proposed event
